**Graduate attributes are the learning outcomes that ALC seeks to realise in all graduates.**

They are:

### **Intellectual**

- Critical and analytical abilities based on sound enquiry
- Enthusiasm to search/research for further knowledge and understanding
- Open-mindedness and receptiveness to new ideas: displays personal and intellectual autonomy
- Expertise in chosen vocational/academic field

### **Professional**

- Knowledge and skills to meet relevant professional and church requirements
- Understanding of and commitment to ethical, social and professional standards and practice
- Information literacy, communication and interpersonal skills
- Commitment to lifelong learning and reflective practice

### **Values**

- Commitment to values consistent with ALC's mission: Christ-centred and spiritually active
- A spirit of service to the community
- Commitment to local, national and global citizenship, contributing in full and meaningful ways
- A high regard for equity and human rights in the context of a broad understanding of globalisation, including respect for individuals, empathy with persons of differing cultural and religious backgrounds, community responsibility and concern for the environment
